

PET POLICY UPDATED 6TH OCTOBER 2025

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Agreement	By paying our pet fee (currently \$10 per pet up to 5 nights) you are agreeing to our pet policies.
Peak Season Blackout	Companion animals are welcome on our caravan and camping sites, excluding peak season December 1st to February 8th.
Pet acceptance	Dogs acceptance is at management discretion. Dogs that are aggressive by nature, history, or perception are restricted to make sure all our guests have a comfortable stay. We reserve the right to decline any dog without providing reason. Please contact the park to discuss your pet before arrival.
Supervision	Dogs must be supervised at all times and not left unattended, including inside a tent or van.
Dogs on a leash	Dogs must be on a leash at all times while not in a van or tent: there are no exceptions. No dog 'runs'.
Common areas	For health and safety reasons, pets are not allowed in any common areas of the park, including camp kitchen, ablutions, playground, BBQ and pool area.
Cabins and Motels	Pets are not allowed in any of our Cabins or Motel Units.
Pet poop	Owners are responsible for picking up and disposing of their pets waste in a sealed bag and disposed of in rubbish bins. If this is not done, a \$200 fee per occurrence may be applied.
Pet washing	For health and safety reasons, pets must not be washed or cleaned anywhere within the park.

Owner responsibility	Pet owners are personally responsible, and will be held to be so, for any and all personal injuries and/or property damage or losses in relation to any actions caused by or because of their pet.
Non-compliance	Management reserves the right to evict any guest whose pet is deemed noisy, disruptive, aggressive or the subject of a complaint/s from other guests. It is the pet owner's sole responsibility to control and manage their pet. If in the view of management this has not happened, the owner and the animal may be evicted from the park immediately.
